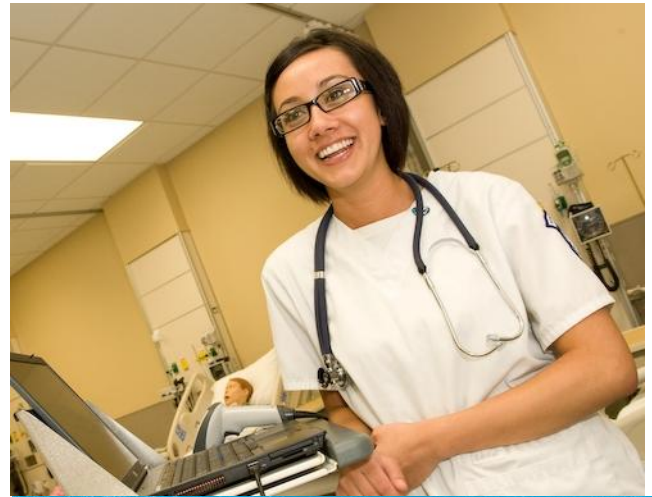

Program Admission Criteria

Applicants are evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- High school diploma or GED equivalent
- Demonstration of success in science and math courses (from either high school or college)
- Demonstration of good physical health
- Demonstration of good written verbal communication skills
- College courses for transfer must be earned at a regionally accredited college and must be completed with a "C-" grade or above

Program Application Process and Deadlines

To be considered for admission the following items must be submitted to the Admissions Office:

- NMC Undergraduate Application with \$25 application fee
- Written personal statement
- Official high school transcript
- If appropriate, official GED test scores
- ACT or SAT official scores (if applicable)
- Official transcripts from all colleges attended

Classes begin in August. Applications will be reviewed until the class is filled. Qualified applicants will meet with an admissions recruiter and the program director as part of the process. The meeting will be scheduled upon receipt of all application materials.

Externship offers real world experience

During the fourth term of the program students gain practical experience through a 10-week, non-paid, supervised externship at one of Methodist Health System's Physician's Clinics or other approved clinical providers. Students are responsible for their own transportation.

Earn an AS degree at NMC
