The Master of Science in Health Promotion Management integrates the art and science of Wellness with leading-edge business practices in change management. The curriculum is aimed at the highest level competencies in the field of health promotion. ### Program highlights:

- Online 16 month program.
- The Master of Science in Health Promotion Management (MHPM) is 33 credit hours. Courses for the MHPM program are delivered through an online five week format. Each course is three credit hours. Students receive a winter break in Dec/Jan.

  - Project
  - Discussion Boards
- Capstone based

- Bachelor degree GPA of 2.5 or above.

## Program Application Process

To be considered for admission the following items must be submitted to the Admissions Office:

- Nebraska Methodist College Graduate Admission application with \$25 application fee.
- One completed graduate reference form.
- Request official transcripts from graduating institutions. (Unofficial transcripts or copies are acceptable through the admissions process; official transcripts are required at the time of enrollment).
- Schedule a professional consultation with representative of the HPM Program.
