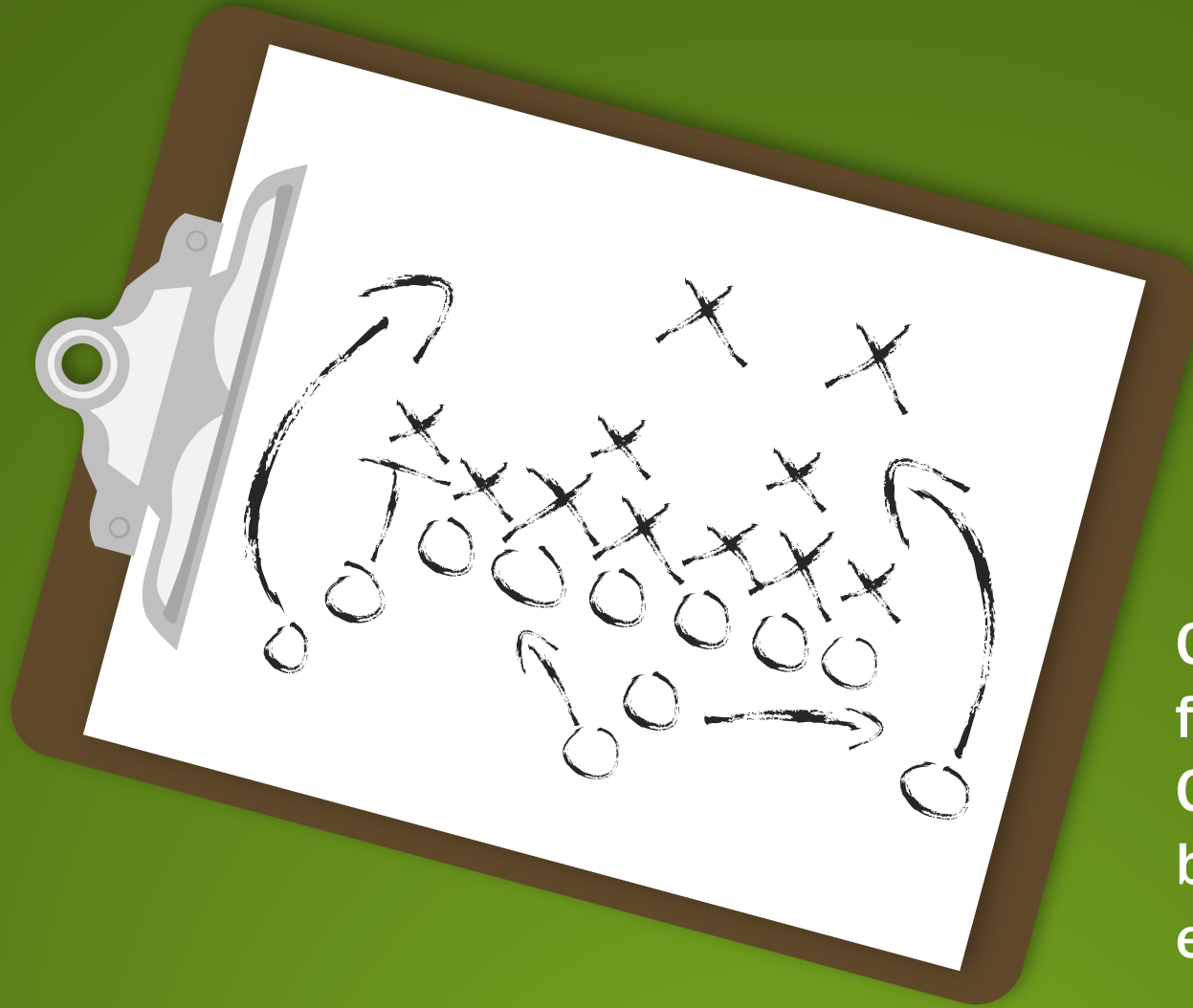

AAP- Clinical Practice Guideline for Diagnosis and Management of Faltering Weight

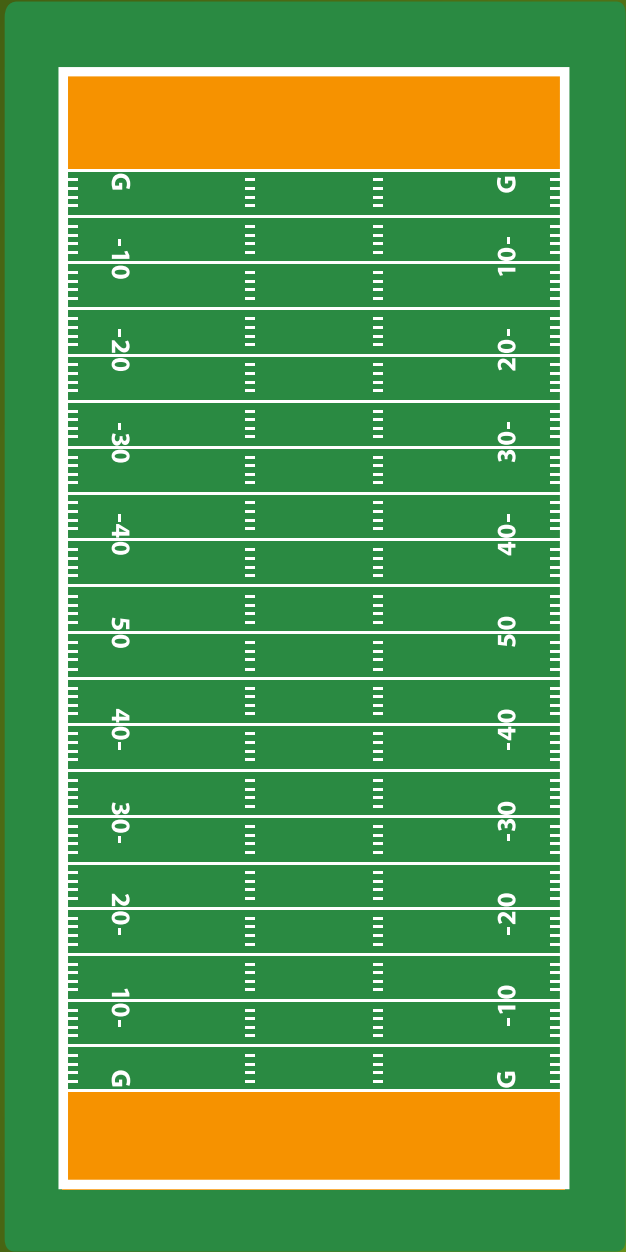


Used to be called Failure To Thrive

Had negative connotations for parents. Definition was based on length and weight percentiles from WHO Growth Charts

Now is called faltering weight.

Use weight and length and a z score is applied. Z-score is a statistical measurement of a distance from the mean. A z-score of 0 is the 50th percentile. No upper and lower limits. When a Z-score is in the negative, it is easier to see growth or loss than using a percentile
