


### **GRNPC EBP Strategies**

- Cross campus GRNPC intranet site expansion to promote a cohesive GRN community



### **Summary**

- Survey: 51% (26/51) RNs council attendees had ≥11 years of clinical experience caring for older adults vs. 35% (18/51) ≤ 10 years
- January-August 2023 & 2024, the GRNPC overall avg. attendance increased from 12-15 monthly
- GRNPC co-chair dyads strengthen GRN training & gerontological board certifications from 60%-80%
