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
## **Background & Purpose**

- Froedtert Health (FH)
   identified a need to enhance
   care for every older adult, by
   providing the best care
   possible.
- Address the specific needs of the older patient and ensure that best practices in geriatric care were consistently applied across the hospital, aiming to improve care quality and reduce variability.

#### Methods

- Implementation of NICHE Model and staff training
- Integration of 4 M's Framework
- Implementation of Geriatric assessment tools into EMR
- Delirium Screening
- Mobility Screening
- Embedding provider goals of care discussion
- Medication screening, guideline use and leveraging order sets

#### Conclusions

Results indicate that integration of NICHE practices and the 4 M's framework with evidence-based tools effectively aligned care and promoted care coordination as well as individualized care planning. This highlights the importance of aligning care, using evidence-based practices, and interdisciplinary collaboration.

- Scaling practices and models of care to the broader health system.
- Capture consistent metrics for evaluating the effectiveness of interventions across the hospital.

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
